





Troop Reminders

- **Review your Troop Roster in MYGS** to make sure all your members are registered for the 2024-2025 membership year.
- **Have you filled out Troop Information Update Form?** Fill it out today to make sure all your information is up-to-date. Link: <u>Troop Information Update</u>
- To access the form: go to www.gsnnj.org, click on Form icon in the upper right corner of the screen for the link to the Troop Information Update form.
- Troop Leaders/Advisors can see the **Background Check eligibility** for adult members under CBC Status column. To review this information login into MYGS Member Profile and under the My Troops Tab in the Adult section look for the CBC Status column.
- Troop Leaders cannot register new members to their troop. Adult or Caregivers must complete the process.

For Leaders: "Invite friends to join your troop"

• Leaders can send friends an email invitation to join their troop from My Troops. (In VS 2.0 **Troop leaders cannot register new girls** directly)

Included in the email is a unique onetime use link that sends the individual to the troop in the Participation Catalog for Membership registration.

- This unique link works only for the recipient you email it to, even if troop is not displayed or showing as having available spots.
- It is not sharable and will not work if pasted into another email or social media post.

Instructions: Log in to your MyGS Account

- 1. Click on **My Troop(s)** tab.
- 2. Select your Troop, to view membership roster
- 3. *Scroll* to bottom of roster.
- 4. Click "Invite friends to join your troop"
- 5. Enter one parent/caregiver email.
- 6. "Submit Request." A confirmation message will appear as "Success! Your invite have been sent."

*Repeat step #4 for each individual invite.
Please verify that parent/caregiver has received the invitation email.

*Please note the invite is only valid for 1 hour.



- 2. *Check* **boxes** for both Membership + Troop/Role Participation for each of the individuals renewing. *Please do not check "Not Returning"
- 3. Click Add Renewal
- 4. Select **2025 Membership Year** (10/1/2024-9/30/2025)
- 5. Click **Review Cart**
- 6. Check box to "I Agree to the Girl Scout Promise and Law"
- 7. Enter Payment



All Lifetime Members must Renew their Participation and Role

Select Role(s) to renew, then click "Add Renewal" Select "None" as Payment Type and Save Details. Click Review Cart, then check I agree to the promise and the law. Click Submit



2025 Service Unit Member Recruitment Campaigns

Each Service Unit has a "SU Name or town" Member Recruitment Unit campaign. Ex: Allendale Member Recruitment Campaign

- Recruitment Campaigns are used as a "holding place" while troops are being formed and for girls looking for a troop.
- SU team members can direct potential volunteers and girls to register to this campaign.
- The SU Campaign Admin role monitors the recruitment campaign and will receive an auto email after a new member completes a membership purchase.
- Would you or another SU Team member like to be added as the SU Campaign Admin so you receive the emails containing contact information of the new member? If so, email <u>customercare@gsnnj.org</u> stating SU Team volunteer to be added to the role.

Steps to sign in:

- Log in to MY GS using the icon on the top right of our home page
- 2. Select MY Account on the top of the screen
- 3. Select gsLearn from the menu on the left
- 4. Select Content Library on the left
- 5. Select Courses
- Enter GSUSA in the search box near the top of the page

The first time you sign in to gsLearn it can take up to 30 minutes for the content to appear.

All new troop leaders must complete the GSUSA New Leader Onboarding courses shown here.

It is recommended that the courses be completed prior to attending New Leader Orientation




